General Terms and Conditions 2017-2018

Dutch Language and Culture for beginners

The general terms and conditions form the formal agreement between LanguageOne Singapore (the School) and the student.

By signing the enrolment form for Dutch Language and Culture for beginners you confirm that you have read, understood and agreed with the General Terms and Conditions.

Registration

The registration of a new student for the school will be accepted as soon as the School is in possession of a signed enrolment form and a copy of the student's passport.

There is a one-off, non-refundable registration fee for new students of SGD 75

Tuition fees 2017-2018

The tuition fee for Dutch Language and Culture for beginners for the academic year 2017-2018 are listed in the table below. The fees include tuition by a qualified teacher and the use of all necessary educational resources.

group lessons (10 x 90 minutes)	SGD	975
private lessons (10 x 60 minutes)	SGD	1.250

Payments

To be allowed to access the programme the full amount of the invoice should be paid before the beginning of the course. The bank details and IBAN number are stated in full on the invoice. For payment, please indicate the debtor number.

The full invoice amount, including registration costs, must be paid. All costs related to the payment, including exchange and bank costs, are to be paid by the student.

Withdrawal

In case of withdrawal by the student on or after the scheduled start date of the course a refund of the fee is not possible.

Cancellation of classes

In the event of cancellation of classes due to unforeseen circumstances, the School will not refund or discount on tuition. If possible, the School will offer the option to make up this missed lesson.

Books

The books are loaned to the students for the duration of the course. In case of loss or damage at the end of the school year the books must be reimbursed to the school based on the purchase price.

Publication of photos and other visual material

The School may occasionally publish photos and other visual material on its website and Facebook page and/or use them for other School publications. If you do NOT want to appear in these publications we kindly request you to state this on the registration form.
